

COVID-19 SITE CHECKLIST

Please use this checklist when you have + cases of COVID-19 in your building (Patients and/or staff)
(Please note these are general recommendations and your facility may do things a little differently, please make sure the COVID email is used to relay any deviations from these recommendations)

- All staff should be wearing N-95 masks at all times, no cloth masks allowed.
- Sites should consider creating multiple units for workers to avoid losing all of the working inmates if that unit ends up on quarantine
- All quarantined patients must remain quarantined for 14 days (please note some facilities are quarantining for 10 days)
- If patient is +, needs to be quarantined for 21 days
- Positive patients/patients with symptoms:
 - Need daily nursing assessments on all +/sxs patients
 - Nursing assessments until quarantine over-if sxs develop refer to provider immediately
 - Daily provider assessments if having symptoms
 - provider should consider ordering COVID-19 med set and CXR
 - Consider ER referral if patient having shortness of breath even if O2sat is stable and lungs are clear-these patients decompensate quickly
 - Make sure you are changing gloves and cleaning any equipment being used in between patients
 - Positive patients should be housed with positive patients when able
 - All moves on and off unit should remain at absolute necessity only
 - Frequent cleaning, social distancing, limited number of patients out of cell at a time, when out of cell, patients must wear a mask and be reminded to wear it properly
